On Monday, we will conduct a multi-tee start across a number of the holes at the Spring Valley Golf Club. The advantage of this is most groups will finish at a similar time. Registration for players will be open from **11.00am**. Team managers are asked to accompany their players/team to **Register before 11.40 am**. This table will be set up around the terrace bar /putting practice area /Golf service Centre area (score cards allocated at this time). Balls can be purchased from the Pro Shop for any who wish to hit up on the range.

Entrance to Spring Valley Golf Club is via 619 Heatherton Road, Clayton South (Melways ef. 79 E10).

*Note: Graham Rd entrance is Member access only.

We ask for punctuality. Latecomers will be allocated penalty strokes. Allow sufficient travel time for your team to arrive at Spring Valley **by 11.00 - 11.30am**. A compulsory **Briefing** for players and Team Managers will be held at **12.00pm**.

The club's nominated **dress code will be enforced**. Please print the relevant documentation accompanying this email (map and dress guide) and hand each player a copy prior to the event. This will assist them finding their way to their tee-off hole and ensure they are appropriately dressed.

SPECTATOR REGISTRATION: It is compulsory **for spectators and all other people not directly involved** with the event to register their name and contact number with the Event Organiser upon arrival at the course (list will be located where Registration takes place). *Spring Valley Golf Club is private property and holds no public responsibility for people roaming their land.*

A reduced fee of **\$60.00** per player will be charged this year (due to coring of greens), plus **\$20.00** per Team Manager will be charged to participating schools (this covers player green fees and post round refreshment packs).
