## AGSV INVITATIONAL GOLF CHAMPIONSHIP 2021 (AGSV – APS – BAS)

Our annual event will take place at the Spring Valley Golf Club on **Monday 26 April 2021**. The event will begin with a briefing for all players and Team Managers at 12.00pm, with the course becoming available from 12:30pm (tee-off). A fee \$75.00 per player will be charged, which covers green fees and refreshments. Team Managers will also be able to enjoy lunch (post event) for \$20.00. **Please don't pay prior to the event** - an invoice will be sent direct to you/ your school's Accounts Department following the tournament for you to authorise.

**Entry conditions for this event:** Players must have an **Official Golf Australia Handicap of 21 or less** in order to play in a team or as an individual.

**Team Entries:** Schools are invited to nominate one team of three-four players for this day. **Girls** can be selected as part of a mixed team, or where a school is able to enter a 'girls only' team, it may be able to do so (in addition to the boys team) providing enough tee spots are available. All girls will **play off the Ladies Tees**.

**Individual Entries:** Schools who cannot not enter a full team can enter up to two individual players to compete for the Individual Trophy.

**Event format:** Stroke Play (ie. gross score 'off the stick'). In the 'Teams event', the best three scores will decide the team score once calculations are finalised. An 'Individual trophy' will be awarded to the player who has the lowest score off the stick. This invite includes a list of the previous winners for your reference.

**A member of staff from each school is required to be in attendance to manage their student/s.** If your school has difficulty providing a member of staff to accompany your students, please make contact to discuss and agree upon an appropriate alternative.

It is the responsibility of the school to ensure that team members are completely familiar with the rules and etiquette of golf. The club dress code is strict and will be enforced:
