



PLAYING CONDITIONS

AGSV v APS Representative Matches

Saturday 12 August 2023 at Penleigh & Essendon Grammar School

The Representative matches between the AGSV and APS will follow playing conditions as outlined in the Regulations.

In all games, if scores are equal at the end of normal time, no extra time will be played.

Australian Rules Football - Girls

- 4 x 18 minute quarters will be played - no time on
- Up to 6 interchange players
- Interval Breaks: 5 minutes at quarter and three-quarter time, 10 minutes at half-time.
- Officials x 3: Field Umpires (appointed by AGSV / APS Convenor)
2 x Goal Umpires and 2 x Boundary (provided by each Association)
2 x Scoreboard and 2 x Timekeepers (provided by Host School).

Australian Rules Football - Boys

- 4 x 20 minute quarters, plus time
- 4 interchange players
- Interval Breaks: 5 minutes at quarter and three-quarter time, 15 minutes at half-time
- Officials x 3: Field Umpires (appointed by AGSV / APS Convenor)
2 x Goal Umpires and 2 x Boundary (provided by each Association)
2 x Scoreboard and 2 x Timekeepers (provided by Host School).

Badminton Boys

- 8 Singles – best of 3 games to 21 points. If the score becomes 20-all, the player who gains a two point lead first shall win the game. If the score becomes 29-all the player winning the next point shall win the game
- 4 Doubles – best of 3 games to 21 points. If the score becomes 20-all, the pair who gains a two point lead shall win the game. If the score becomes 29-all the pair winning the next point shall win the game.

Basketball - Boys & Girls

- 4 x 8 minute quarters
- Time outs: Maximum of 2 time outs per team per half
- Clock stops on all whistles throughout the game
- Interval Breaks: two minutes at half time, one minute at quarter and three-quarter time
- 24 second shot-clock will operate
- Officials: x3 Referees (provided by Basketball Victoria) & 4 x Scorers/Timekeepers (provided by host school).



Cross Country

- Distances Girls 3.45 km, Boys 5.64 km,
- Boys team of up to 12 with 10 runners to count (spikes are permitted)
Results: Placegetters to be recorded in order of finish (APS, AGSV) lowest tally wins
- Girls team of up to 10 with 6 runners to count (spikes are permitted)
Results: Placegetters from all three Associations to be recorded in order of finish (APS, AGSV, GSV) but only tally places from AGSV & APS competitors
- Officials: Course Marshalls and x3 Recorders (provided by Host school).

Hockey – Boys & Girls Hockey

- 4 x 17-minute quarters. There will be no time-outs for goals or corners
- Interval Break: 5 minutes at half-time and 3 minutes at the end of each quarter
- Up to 5 interchange players of which one must be a Goal Keeper
- The wearing of mouthguards and a box is strongly recommended
- Penalty corner: it is mandatory that any defending player wear a protective mask, including the runner. Players are now permitted to keep wearing their mask until the ball reaches the 23 meter line. Players not involved in a penalty corner are to stand over the half line
- Wearing of shinpads is mandatory (all players)
- The tomahawk shot is permitted
- Officials: 2 x Umpires (appointed by Hockey Victoria) and 1 x Scoreboard operator (provided by Host School).

Netball

- 4 x 15 minute quarters
- Interval Breaks: 3 minutes at quarter and three-quarter time, 5 minutes at half-time
- Up to 5 interchange players
- Injury/illness stoppages which will include blood, will be up to 30 seconds and the player concerned must leave the court
- Officials: 2 x A-Grade umpires (appointed by AGSV)
- 2 x Scorers/Timekeepers (provided by Host School).

Soccer - Boys & Girls

- 2 x 40 minute halves
- Up to 5 interchange players of which one must be a Goal Keeper
- Interval Break: 10 minutes at half-time
- Officials: 1 x Central referee and 2x Assistant Referees (Lines) (arranged by Host school)
- 1 x Scoreboard operator (provided by Host School).
