

Food Safety Policy General

1. Statement of Context

AGSV Member Schools with permanent canteens or temporary food premises, including at sporting events, must ensure compliance with food safety and food handling regulations, including but not limited to:

- having a food safety supervisor with the training, skills and knowledge to ensure that:
 - o all regulations are followed
 - \circ $\,$ anyone handling food has the correct training
- ensuring a food safety program is prepared based on the Department of Human Services template
- lodging the food safety program with the municipal council at the time of registration and re-registration.
